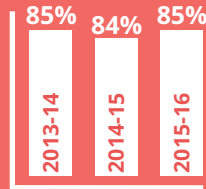

85% of students at Wheatley Middle School believe their school is a safe place.



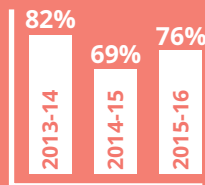
## STUDENTS BELIEVE THEIR SCHOOL IS A SAFE PLACE

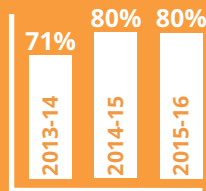
## SAM HOUSTON HIGH SCHOOL

76% of students at Sam Houston High School believe their school is a safe place.



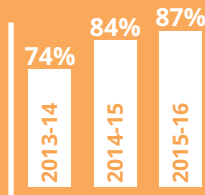
## STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT EXPERIENCED BULLYING AT THEIR SCHOOL

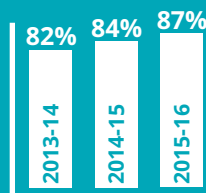
**SAM HOUSTON HIGH SCHOOL**
